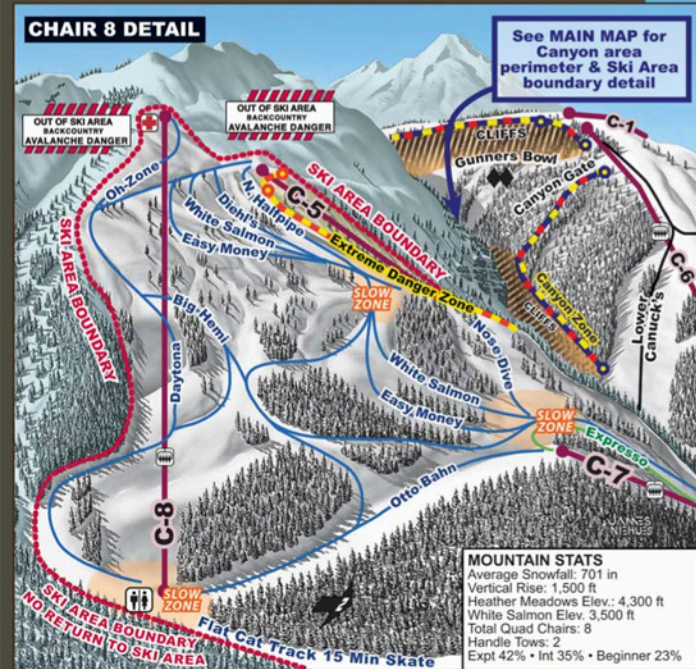


CHAIR 8 DETAIL



RCW 79a.45.030

In addition to other responsibilities and codes of conduct, Washington Law RCW 79A.45.030 provides that anyone skiing outside of the confines of designated trails or runs open for skiing within the ski area boundary shall be responsible for any injuries or losses resulting from his or her action. Designated trails and runs are identified on the trail map. Areas bordering and between designated trails or runs are not designated trails or runs. It is your responsibility to know and follow all Mountain Policies. Information is available on the inside of our Trail Map, on our website at www.mtbaker.us, and posted at the Ski Area.
