Alpine Responsibility Code

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the slopes, always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe outdoor experience.

- 1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people or objects.
- 2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- 3. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4. Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- 5. If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
- 6. Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 7. Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
- 8. Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- 9. You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
- You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.

President's Message

2010 ~ Welcome to Boler Mountain!

Welcome to the 2010/11 winter season at Boler! We trust your experience at Boler will be enjoyable each and every time you are here. The focus of the staff and volunteers at Boler Mountain is to provide all quests with quality service and the best recreational experience within our resources. We are not Whistler, but we can provide exceptional learn to ski/snowboard programs, an opportunity to hone your advanced skills for the bigger hills through instruction and practice, as well as a worthwhile and accessible winter outing for you and your family.

Boler Mountain is a not-for-profit organization governed by a volunteer board, run by a dedicated and very experienced management team, along with over 250 seasonal employees. We have more than 100,000 skier/snowboarder visits each year, and provide learn to ski programs for almost 10,000 school children. We have a busy separate tube park. We are host to the London Track 3 program and its 200 volunteers who provide skiing opportunities to the physically and developmentally challenged.

The Boler Mountain ski club has been a wintertime fixture in London since 1946. Thanks to the remarkable foresight shown almost seven decades ago, we have a 120 acre woodland facility available to serve London and surrounding areas. While the focus to date has been on winter sports, we are hoping to show the same foresight in carefully developing the property as a year round community recreational resource. Our summertime activities have been slowly expanding beyond the mountain bike programs we have run for the last ten years, and we are looking to establish summer camps in the near future.

Through some cautious planning and management, we have had a program of continual capital improvement to the outdoor operations while maintaining a solid financial footing. Our new snow making system is second to none. The operations centre built last year provides the infrastructure and capacity for our expansion to the west, and our grooming equipment is first class. While our chalet may leave something to be desired, it adequately serves its purpose for now and it is on the list for later improvement.

We have some ambitious plans ahead of us. Our West Hill expansion is nearing completion, with the final shaping of the runs underway. Take the walk west of the chalet to see for yourself. A chair lift has been purchased and is ready to be installed. The next steps involve installation of snow making and lighting. It is our hope to have the West Hill in operation by the winter of 2011/12. Many thanks to our operations manager Marty Thody and his staff for an exceptional effort throughout!

On behalf of the board of directors and the staff, it is our hope that you enjoy the time you spend at Boler Mountain. We are always looking for feedback, suggestions and constructive criticism. Feel free to contact our managers, Marty, Greg and Wayne, our board members and myself.



- 3. Boler Mountain reserves the right to remove a season pass or lift ticket at their discretion.
- Each season pass holder is required to sign a RELEASE OF LIABILITY form before picking up their pass.
- 5. A \$20.00 charge will be made for replacement of lost passes. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when replacing a lost pass.
- 6. Passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- 7. Season passes must be worn and visible at all times while at the ski area.

 Lift ticket will not be issued for a forgotten pass.
- 8. The management reserves the right to close the area at any time it deems it unsafe to the public.
- 9. All rates are subject to change without notice.
- 10. Season Passes include a \$20 improvement fee per person; day tickets include a \$1.00 improvement fee for the new West Hill expansion.


