DIRECTIONS

The Harrison Hills Winter Recreation Area can be reached from:

Merrill - Highway 17 north to County Trunk B, north on B to Chain O Lakes Road

Tomahawk - County Trunk D east to County Trunk B, south on B to Chain

O Lakes Road

Rhinelander - Highway 17 south to County Trunk B, north on B to Chain O Lakes Road

CROSS-COUNTY SKI TRAIL

The Harrison Hills ski trail consists of two loops which begin at the parking area. The trail traverses lakes and beautiful rolling hills. The extremely scenic trail is designed for an intermediate skier but a beginner should be able to ski the shorter loop. The west loop is approximately 2 miles long and the perimeter of both loops together is approximately 5 miles. The trails are marked and groomed.

DOWNHILL SKIING

The Harrison Hills downhill ski area has 5 slopes. It has 3 rope tows and has a vertical rise of approximately 200'. The runs range in length from 400' to 2000'. The slopes are laid out to accomodate the beginner through the expert skier. The hill is in operation weekends and holidays 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

SNOWMOBILING

The Harrison Hills snowmobile trail passes through the area. Parking is available on County trunk B at the Elm City parking area and at the Harrison Hills parking area. Snowmobilers are welcome at the chalet to warm up and for hot drinks and snacks. The snowmobile trail receives regular grooming. North, the trail goes to Harrison, Tomahawk and connects with Langlade and Oneida County trails. South, the trail goes to Gleason, Doering, Underdown and Merrill.

CHALET

The chalet is open during downhill skiing operation. It features a fireplace, snack bar and ski patrol.

OTHER FEATURES

The Harrison Hills winter recreation area includes a sledding area for youngsters. The many lakes in the area offer ice fishing.
