SENSATION QUAD
Sensation Quad includes More Difficult and Most Difficult terrain only. Ski/rider access to other Spruce lifts and base area is via the Most Difficult trails only.

HIGH HAZARD AREA
In the summer of 2014, a severe microburst hit this portion of the Mansfield State Forest. While ALL off-designated-trail skiing & riding presents increased risks and hazards, this area contains extremely hazardous: fallen trees, roots, unstable terrain, debris and unseen openings.
WE STRONGLY WARN THAT YOU DO NOT SKI OR SNOWBOARD IN THIS AREA DUE TO THE ADDED RISKS CAUSED BY THE STORM DAMAGE.

SKI AREA BOUNDARY
The area beyond this boundary is hazardous backcountry terrain, containing unmarked hazards such as cliffs, thick brushy terrain, overhanging, stumps, rocks & avalanches. This area is not patrolled or maintained.
VT law states that a person who uses ski area facilities to access terrain that is outside the open & designated trails shall be liable for any costs of rescue, medical or other services.

Trail difficulty ratings: ■ ■ ■ ■ are relative to trails at Stowe.
Trail ratings of Stowe should not be compared to those found at other resorts.
