Mountains

Bald Mountain: Elevation 8,400 feet, offers ideal terrain for beginner and intermediate skiers. First-time skiers will find the separate, protected beginners' area known as Wide Open. Accessed by two chairlifts, Burns and Snowflake. Runs on Bald Mountain served as the venue for Deer Valley's 2002 Winter Games events - Champion, site of the freestyle mogul event; Know You Don't, site of the slalom event; and the site of the freestyle aerial events. The Silver Lake high-speed detachable quad chairlift gives skiers fast access to the Lake area.

Baldy Peak: ski terrain includes nine trails, ranging from beginner to experts. The trails are accessible via the Resort's Little Stick Gondola, or by riding the Jordanelle Express Gondola, or by riding the Mayflower/Deer Crest entrance on Hwy 40.

Flagstaff Mountain: Elevation 9,100 feet, offers a variety of skiing terrain for all ability levels. New this season, the Judge lift, a fixed-grip triple and the Silver Strike Express, a detachable quad. In addition we have added two new runs, Gemini and Lily. Ontario Bowl can be accessed from either Red Cloud, Quincy, Northside Express or Silver Strike Express where you will find rolling untracked terrain with open faces and glades.

Empire Canyon: Elevation 9,570 feet, offers six intermediate runs along with some of the most advanced skiing at Deer Valley. The Daly Chutes, eight very steep, rock-lined chutes will challenge even seasoned, expert skiers. New this season, Tricks 'n Turns (TNT) Park features the latest in family-oriented fun! 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YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.
