



New Jersey State Law requires all ski & snowboard participants age 17 & under to wear ski helmets while on the trails and lifts. It is the responsibility of the parent, legal guardian or supervising adult to ensure that helmets are provided and worn. Mountain Creek recommends helmets for ALL skiers and snowboarders regardless of age. Skiers and snowboarders are encouraged to educate themselves on the benefits and limitations of helmet use.

Terrain Zones

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 Critical Areas indicated in yellow on design are areas strong or feeding and learning areas. Please do not overboard fish in these areas at all times. Snow skiing and sliding are endorsed in these areas.

 Freestyle Terrain may contain jumps, fins, ramps, embankments, fish bowls, (fin, tails, half pipes, quarter pipes, crooked), freestyle bumps, wrecks and other unclassified or natural terrain features. Freestyle skill involves maintaining control on the ground and in the air. Prior to using freestyle terrain, it is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with and follow all instructions and
