



Powder Days

The entire mountain is accessible to all ability levels. We recommend novice and intermediate skiers try Whiskey Jack, Sundance, Christmas Bowl, Gypsy Queen, Sunny Ridge and Just Dandy. For advanced and expert skiers Attridge, the Chute, Headwall, Quicksilver, Holy Smokes and Bon Diablo will be the ticket.

Sunny Day

The skiling will be fantastic and the views, outstanding. For some of the best groomed cruising anywhere in the world head to Gypsy Queen, Sunny Ridge or try Bon Diablo or Black Pine when they have had the expert touch of our Winch Cat Grooming.

When Visibility is Limited

Conditions vary widely on the mountain. Ask a staff member where the best conditions are. Stick to the narrower runs, close to the treeline, where slope definition will be best.

Be Prepared

High mountain weather can change rapidly and dramatically. Dress properly and be prepared for all conditions. If you choose to go out of bounds, you are responsible. We recommend avalanche awareness training, bringing a transceiver, shovel, probe, and that you not go alone. Natural hits are everywhere. Have someone check your landing before jumping. Don't jump on green runs.

Know Your Boundaries! Silver Star Mountain Resort has no obligation to anyone going beyond ski area boundaries. Should persons choose to leave the ski area, they do so at their own risk & assume the burden of responsibility for their actions. Avalanche danger and other hazards exist. You are solely responsible for your safety, welfare, and costs of rescue.

Alpine Responsibility Code

THERE ARE ELEMENTS OF RISK THAT COMMON SENSE AND PERSONAL AWARENESS CAN HELP REDUCE. REGARDLESS OF HOW YOU DECIDE TO USE THE SLOPES, ALWAYS SHOW COURTESY TO OTHERS. PLEASE ADHERE TO THE CODE LISTED BELOW AND SHARE WITH OTHERS THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A SAFE OUTDOOR

- 1 Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people or objects
- People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is YOUR responsibility to avoid them.
- 3 Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4 Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.

- 5 Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 6 Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
- 7 You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or
- 8 If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
- 9 Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- 10 You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.
