The Nordic trails wrap around the entire mountain, meaning you can ski from the Village to Paradise Camp and meet up with friends and family who might be downhill skiing. Beginners can access the upper trail network by taking the chairlift and enjoying a casual, meandering ski back to the Village. What a great way to spend a sunny winter's day!

Favorite Nordic Trails

Meadow Trail - 4 km - An easy tour around the Knoll to Silver Lake. Watch the ice skaters in action and stop at the Tube Town Cantina for hot chocolate and great hamburgers.

Paradise Camp – 5 km – An easy descent winding around the north side of the mountain. Stop in at Paradise Camp for great soup and sandwiches enroute back to the village.

Sidewinder - 3.5 km - Silver Star's best viewpoint trail, and an easy ski for beginners. This side trip from Meadow Trail passes the Biathlon Range and Cabin which then connects with Mtn. View where you will find an amazing lookout and cabin.

Alder Point - 5 km - New this season is the Alder Point connector looping back to Comin' Round the Mountain.

Knoll Skiways - 2 km - Two trails around the Knoll providing a closeup view of the Victorian homes.

Paradise Lake / Step-Turn Hill - 1.5 km - A fun side trip off Paradise Trail that goes around the reservoir and the rejoins the main trail after an exciting set of switchbacks that go from easy to "interestina"!

World Cup - 3 km - The name says it all. This trail was used for the 1991 World Cup hosted at Silver Star Mountain Resort.




