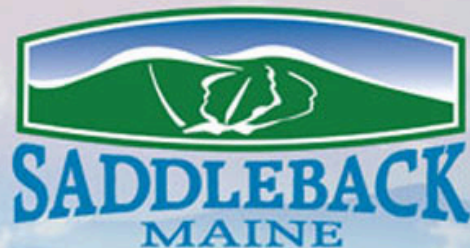

 by Kennebago Quad Chair and Kennebago Station.



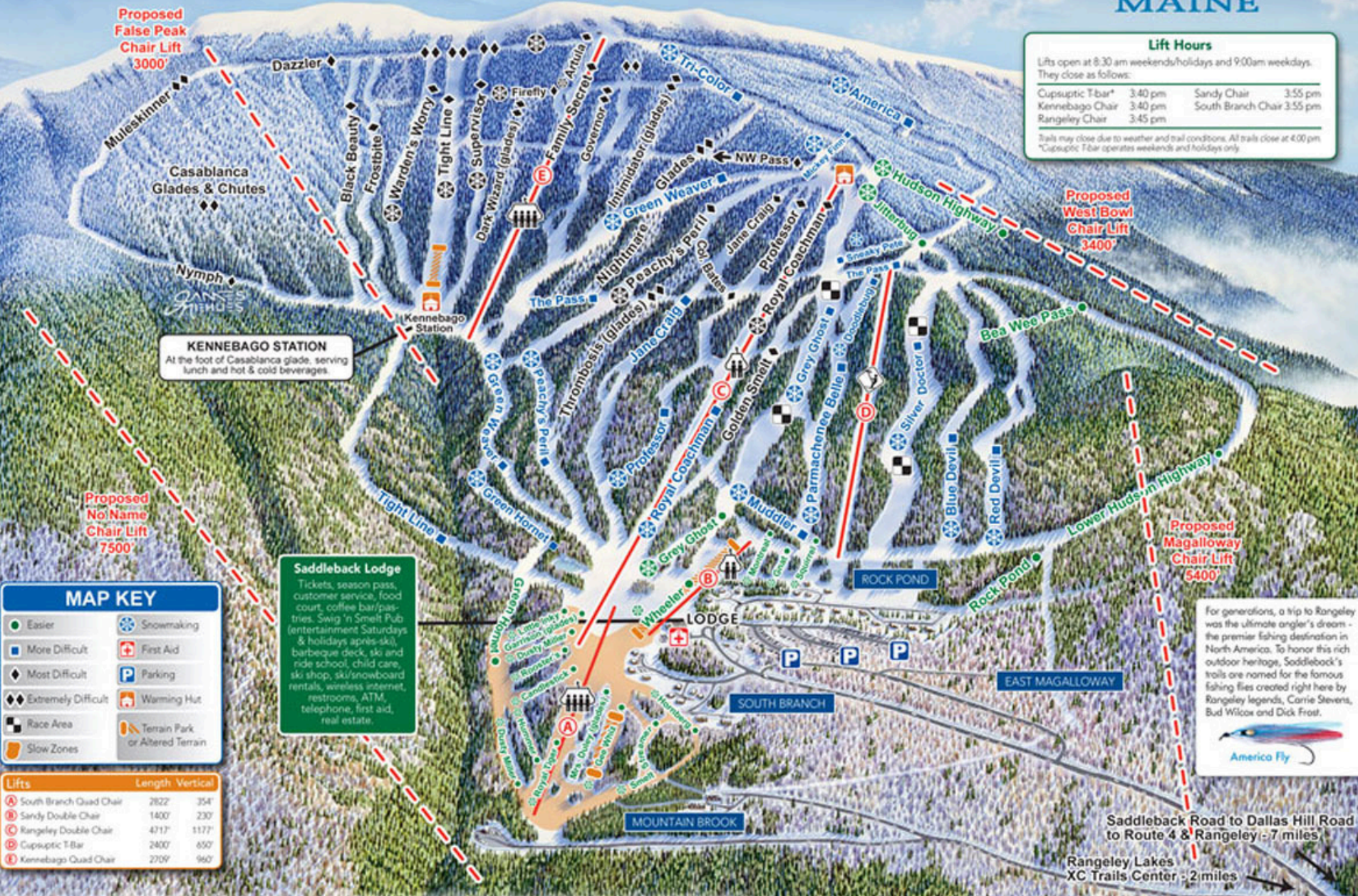
