YOUR RESPONSIBILITY - COLORADO SKI SAFETY ACT

The Colorado legislature established as a matter of law that certain dangers and risks are inherent in the sport of skiing.

WARNING
Under Colorado law, a skier assumes the risk of any injury to person or property resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing and may not recover from any ski area operator for any injury resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing including: changing weather conditions, existing and changing snow conditions, bare spots, rocks, stumps, trees, collisions with natural objects, man-made objects or other skiers, variations in terrain, and the failure of skiers to ski within their own abilities. Colorado law includes cliffs, jumps, extreme and freestyle terrain in the inherent dangers and risks of skiing.

HELMET USAGE
Winter Park Resort strongly recommends wearing helmets for skiing and riding. Skiers and snowboarders are encouraged to educate themselves on the benefits and limitations of helmet usage. Your primary safety consideration, and obligation under Your Responsibility Code, is to ski and ride in a controlled and responsible manner.

SHARE THE SLOPES
Skiing can be enjoyed in many ways. At ski areas you may see people using alpine, snowboard, telemark, cross-country, or other specialized ski equipment, such as that used by disabled or other skiers. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

WIND ENERGY
Wind energy credits are used to offset power consumption for all new lifts including the Village Cabriolet, Super Gauge Express, Eagle Wind and Panoramic Express.

RENEWABLE RESOURCES
Renewable/recycled products are used throughout Winter Park Resort and are bought from responsible environmental practices.

FOREST STEWARDSHIP
Winter Park Resort is working closely with the US Forest Service in implementing a Vegetation Management Plan to improve forest health throughout the resort in response to recent effects of Mountain Pine Beetle activity. Please be aware that throughout the winter season tree islands may be closed, as designated with rope closures or signs, to allow for forest regeneration.

RECYCLING
Recycling containers for plastic, aluminum and paper are located throughout Winter Park Resort. FSC certified products are also utilized in printed materials.
