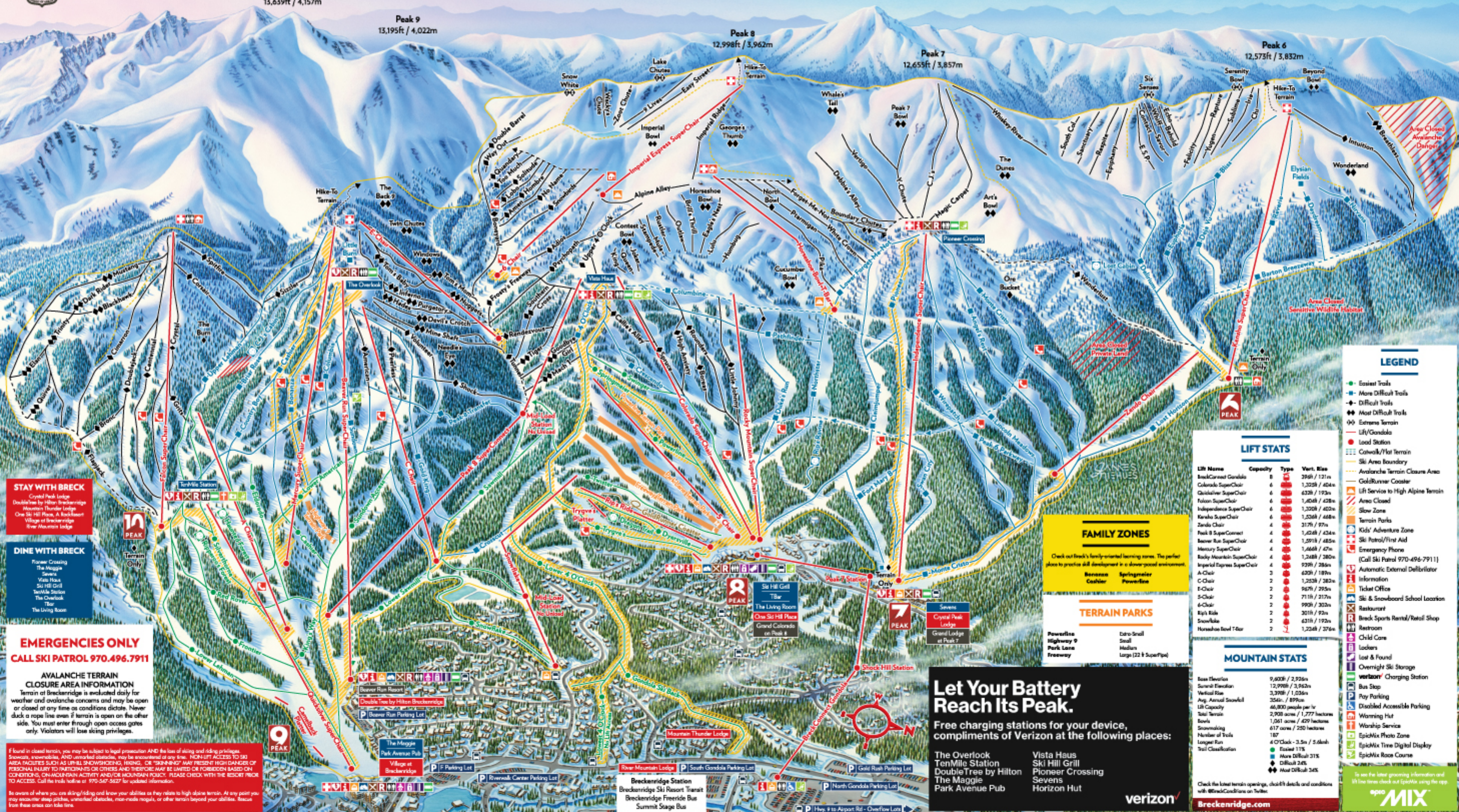

AVAILANCE TERRAIN CLOSURE AREA INFORMATION
Terrain at Breckenridge is evaluated daily for weather and avalanche concerns and may be open or closed at any time as conditions dictate. Never duck a rope line even if terrain is open on the other side. You must enter through open access gates only. Violators will lose skiing privileges.

If found in closed terrain, you may be subject to legal prosecution AND the loss of skiing and riding privileges. Snowcats, snowblowers, AND unmarked obstacles, may be encountered at any time. NON-LIFT ACCESS TO SKI AREA FACILITIES SUCH AS LIFT LINE SNOWSHEDS, FIRING, OR "SOONING" MAY PRESENT HIGH DANGERS OF PERSONAL INJURY TO PARTICIPANTS OR OTHERS AND THEREFORE MAY BE LIMITED OR FORBIDDEN BASED ON CONDITIONS, ON-MOUNTAIN ACTIVITY AND/OR HOURS/PAUSE. PLEASE CHECK WITH THE RESORT PEAK TO ACCESS. Call the trails hotline at 970-567-5627 for updated information.
As owners of where you are skiing/riding and know your abilities as you relate to high alpine terrain. At any point you may encounter steep pitches, unmarked obstacles, non-routine moguls, or other terrain beyond your abilities. Retreat from these areas can take time.
