BACKSIDE LIFTS: 3, 5, 8 9am - 3:30pm The following trails may have modified hours:


- McCormack's Maze closes at 2pm daily.

Lower Wapiti & Lower Bull Run closes at 2pm, when Lift 5 Grizzly Lift is not operating.

If unfamiliar with a lift, ask the operator for instructions. Some trails close earlier to allow riders adequate time to descend the mountain.
