#### LIFT HOURS OF OPERATION

**FRONTSIDE LIFTS 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10** 9am – 4pm

**BACKSIDE LIFTS: 3, 5, 8** 9am – 3:30pm

The following trails may have modified hours:

• **McCormack's Maze** closes at 2pm daily.

• **Lower Wapiti & Lower Bull Run** closes at 2pm, when Lift 5 Grizzly Lift is not operating.

If unfamiliar with a lift, ask the operator for instructions. Some trails close earlier to allow riders adequate time to descend the mountain.

Lift operations may change throughout the season. Check the snow report or ask Guest Services for the most current information.
