POWDER BUMPS

The Bergbahn AG Kitzbühel seek to offer our guests optimum piste conditions for every skiing day. In case of new snowfall, however, they will not be able to groom all trails at the same time, even when using a maximum of grooming machines. Under certain weather conditions, new snow is bonding poorly to the underlying snow surface. Despite compacting roller grooming, new bumps (moguls) are formed by skiers' first turns, which does not come from poor trail grooming.



3. Pure Enjoyment Trail

Boarders Paradise


