Garibaldi Provincial Park



Garibaldi Provincial Park is a wilderness area and is not patrolled or avalanche controlled. Steep slopes and chutes are prone to avalanche hazards. Persons outside the Whistler Blackcomb ski area boundary who are not prepared for backcountry travel and self rescue could be charged for rescue costs.

SAFETY

Know It, Respect It, Ride It.

- If you see an accident on the hill that requires first aid, cross skis or lay board above the site and report the location and type of injury to the nearest staff member.
- Whistler Blackcomb recommends **helmet usage** for skiing or riding.
- Watch for changing conditions — natural or man-made.
- Vehicles may be encountered on Whistler Blackcomb Mountains. Please slow down and give them a wide berth.
- Irresponsible, reckless, or discourteous skiing and riding on any part of the mountain may result in loss of lift access privileges.
- **Caution** Snow immersion suffocation from deep snow or tree wells can be fatal. Always ride with a partner. **Visit deepsnowsafety.org**
- Difficulty ratings are relative to each ski area. Skiers and riders should work their way up starting with the easiest run, regardless of their ability level.
- **Signage** and fencing are used to inform you of the presence of a potential obstacle or hazard. Be aware that some hazards are not marked, use caution at all times.

Respect the Mountains

Skiing and riding beyond the area boundary may result in a lengthy hike, an overnight in the wilderness, and/or a potentially costly rescue. If you go, be prepared. Closed means closed. Violators will lose lift privileges.

Respect Others

Respect Slow Zones. These are areas where children and beginners are most likely to be. There are no hits or jumps in this area.

Respect Yourself

Know your limits. There is no disgrace in declining a descent you are not comfortable with.

Freestyle skills require maintaining control on the ground and in the air. Use of Freestyle Terrain exposes you to the risk of serious injury or death. Inverted aerials are not recommended. You assume the risk.

BEGINNER ZONES

Whistler Blackcomb has ideal learning terrain. No matter what lift you take up, there's an easy route down.

- **Olympic "Mid" Station (Whistler Mountain)** Midway up the Whistler Village Gondola. Slow-skiing Beginners' Zone, Children's Learning Centre, easy-loading Olympic Chair and Magic Carpets.
- **Magic Chair Area (Blackcomb Mountain)** Easy-loading triple chair, Magic Carpets, Whistler Kids location; all next to the handy Rentals and Daylodge Services at the base of Blackcomb Mountain.

What's Next?

Once you've got your legs under you, here are just a few ways to explore a bit more of our two mountains.

- **Slow Zones** See yellow highlighted areas on map where the areas are monitored for your safety.
- **Blackcomb Mountain** Expressway to Easy Out accessed from the Solar Coaster Express is perfect for both skiers and snowboarders. Green Line from the top of 7th Heaven is an easy traverse for skiers.
- **Whistler Mountain** Use Whiskey Jack or Ego Bowl in the Family Zone accessible from Emerald Express and the top of the Whistler Village Gondola.

FREE MOUNTAIN TOURS

Offered daily for intermediate and advanced skiers and snowboarders at 11:15am from December 12, 2015 - April 17, 2016 — conditions permitting.

- **Whistler Mountain** From the Guest Satisfaction Centre, under the light board near the top of the Whistler Village Gondola.
- **Blackcomb Mountain** From the Guest Satisfaction Centre at the top of Solar Coaster Express.
- **Blackcomb Glacier Tour** For advanced skiers and riders only. From the Guest Satisfaction Centre, top of Solar Coaster Express.

- **Tree Fort** Access from Bear Cub trail, near the Big Red Express.
- **Family Zone** Underneath Emerald Express with something for everyone.
- **Harmony Bowl** Steeps, glades, bumps and easy cruisers.

Symphony Amphitheatre – Whistler Mountain
Access to tune bowl from the Symphony Express, Harmony Express or Peak Express chairs. Visibility and conditions in future Bowl can change rapidly. When in doubt, follow piste trail markers. Please follow all posted signs for boundary notification.



7th Heaven – Blackcomb Mountain
When the sun is shining, slip on the sunscreen and head for Heaven. Take skiers' left for panoramic cruising and amazing across-the-valley views of Whistler Mountain. To return to the Rendezvous, stay to skiers' right on Green Line.



Blackcomb Glacier
Enter from the top of the showcases T-Bar, or experts can use the Sparky's Ladder entrance, accessed from the top of the glacier express. Designated runs in this area are located within Blackcomb Glacier Provincial Park and are managed under a Park Use Permit for the purposes of snow and avalanche control. Closures will be in effect when avalanche danger exists and blasting may be in progress.

This whole area is green to help you learn. Offroad midway on the Whistler Village Gondola and proceed to the Olympic Chair.

SLOW ZONES

Keep an eye out for our Mountain Safety Team in their bright yellow jackets monitoring the Slow Zones. Slow Zones are in effect in teaching areas and congested zones for your safety. Please also watch for the bright orange banners that indicate all traffic must travel in a slow, controlled manner.

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the slopes, always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe outdoor experience.

- Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
- Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
- Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
- You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability, and knowledge to safely load, ride, and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.
