LEARN THE TYPES OF TERRAIN


Sun Valley's Dollar Mountain and Bald Mountain encompass very diverse landscape. It is important to understand the different terrain offered in order to use it safely alongside all other mountain guests.

"GO WITH THE FLOW" TERRAIN

These areas of the mountain are for a more relaxed and social atmosphere designed to accommodate the widest range of skiers and riders. A "Go with the Flow" approach sets the tone for an inclusive, fun, and welcoming environment for all ages and ability levels.

FREESTYLE TERRAIN

Freestyle Terrain, as opposed to groomed runs, can contain jumps, hits, ramps, banks, boxes, rails, and other man-made features. The orange "Smart Style" symbol identifies freestyle terrain on the mountain-



· Look Before You Leap: Scope around the jumps first, not over them. Know your landings are clear and clear yourself out of the landing area.
