MORSE MOUNTAIN

- 1 Village Center** – 3 Mountain Outfitters sport shop, Guest Services, Owner Services, Wyndham Preview Center, Country Store, The Perk Coffee Shop, Ticket Sales, *Snow Sport University* sign-ups and the Ski & Ride Desk.
- 2 The Village Lodge** – Village Pizzeria, Ben & Jerry's Scoop Shop, Green Mountain Deli, and Bootleggers' Lounge.
- 3 The Meeting House** – Family friendly dining in a relaxed atmosphere at the Morse Mountain Grille & Pub. Offering breakfast, lunch, and dinner options. Kids can select from our Little Smugglers' menu.
- 4 Hearth & Candle** – Fine family dining, or quiet white-tablecloth dining for adults only in the Birch Room. Young diners can enjoy the award-winning kids menu.
- 5 3 Mountain Equipment** – Ski and snowboard rental equipment, tuning and repairs, custom boot fitting and a large inventory of brand name equipment available for purchase.
- 6 Sir Henry's Learning Hill** – A gentle practice area with surface lifts and warming pavilion. Ski Patrol first aid room.
- 7 Morse Highlands & Day Lodge** – A special learning area with cafeteria dining for breakfast and lunch. Home of the Log Jam Terrain Park – this beginner-friendly park typically has small style rails, gentle snow features like rollers, and a fun box, perfect for both adults and children.
- 8 TREASURES** – Our fully-licensed child care center for children ages 6 weeks to 3 years. Home of *Little Rascals on Snow* and a Wonder Carpet lift.
- 9 Nordic Ski & Snowshoe Adventure Center** – Featuring 30km of cross-country trails, 24km of snowshoe trails, and outdoor ice rink. Nordic, snowshoe, and ice skate equipment rental available.
- 10 FunZone 2.0** – A one-of-the-kind 26,000 square foot indoor playground for all ages! Challenge the family to a race through an inflated obstacle course or on a double-sided transparent climbing wall. Choose your slot car for a hair-raising run on the Mountain Rally Raceway. Plan your team's battle strategy for a round of laser tag. Bounce to your heart's content in the Bouncy House or inflated Pirate Ship. Refuel at the ReFuel Café with a pizza, panini or wrap, or with snacks such as soft serve ice cream or popcorn. The Café also serves hot and cold drinks, beer and wine, and much more.



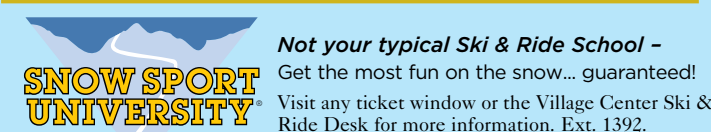
MADONNA MOUNTAIN

- 11 Base Lodge** – Lift ticket purchase outside at ticket window, Season Pass and Bash Badge purchase inside the Lobby. Full-line cafeteria menu and seating upstairs.
- Green Peppers** – Featuring tasty deli sandwiches & soups.
- Black Bear Tavern** – Features a pub menu along with our largest selection of beer and cider on the Mountain! Enjoy après sport parties every Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. (12/7/18 - 4/7/19)
- 3 Mountain Outfitters** – Goggles, gloves, and outerwear options for the whole family. Discounted jackets and outerwear.
- 3 Mountain Equipment** – Equipment rental, tuning, and repair services available.
- 12 Waffle Cabin** – Enjoy a grab-and-go slopeside treat at the Waffle Cabin located near the Madonna II lift.
- 13 Flowground on Lower FIS** – The Flowground incorporates innovative trail grooming with subtle terrain features. Contoured with berms, rolls, banks, and progression features perfect for preparing intermediate skiers and riders for more challenging terrain.
- 14 Knight's Revenge Terrain Park** – This natural feature freestyle park is in the Knight's Revenge intermediate/advanced glades and will contain log slides and rolls, bank turns, rock jumps, a rainbow, ramps, and loads of rails – more than twenty features in all!



STERLING MOUNTAIN

- 15 Birch Run Terrain Park** – At the base of Sterling Mountain, this park is designed for intermediate level skiers and riders with modified table tops, rails, and boxes.
- 16 Top of the Notch** – Warm up with a famous bowl of Venison Stew in this beautiful Post & Beam building. Hot & cold beverages, assorted snacks, and a wide variety of sandwich wraps are available. Location of the Snowshoe Adventure Dinner.
- 17 The Zone** – On Sterling Mountain's Practice Slope, The Zone features multiple sets of progression jump lines and rails.

- 19 Parking Lot 1 Yurt** – A great spot to warm up or switch in or out of your ski or snowboard boots.



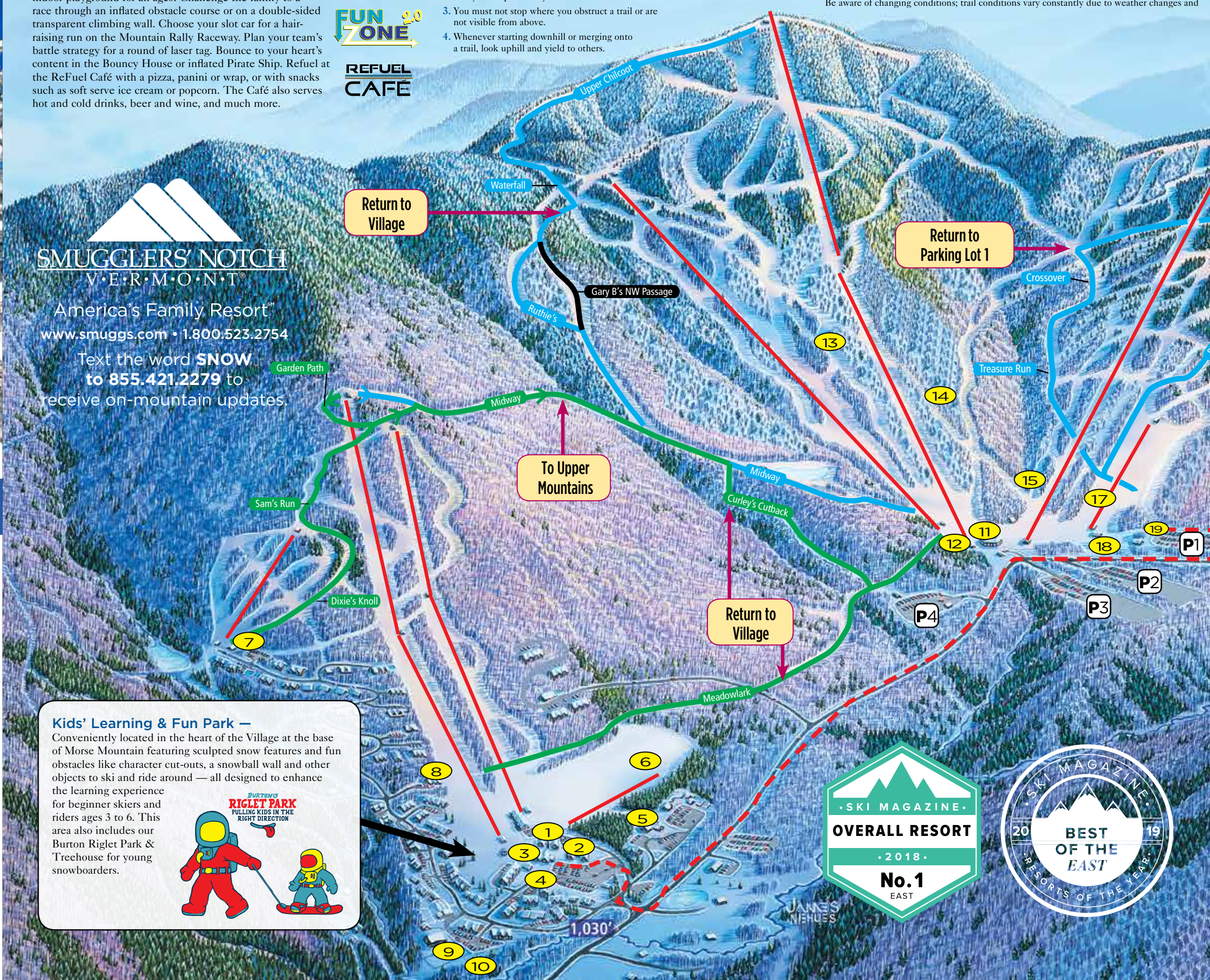

Your Responsibility Code

Snow sports can be enjoyed in many ways. You may see people at Smugglers' Notch using alpine, telemark or cross-country skis, snow blades, snowboards, and other specialized equipment. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy our trails, there are elements of risk. Use common sense, show courtesy to others, and anticipate dangerous situations before they arise. The following guidelines represent the most basic common sense and courtesy:

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.

5. Always use devices that prevent runaway equipment.
 6. Observe all posted signs and warnings and keep clear of any potential hazard.
 7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride, and unload safely.
 8. Respect the mountain. Please do not litter, either with trash or with foul language.
- This is just a partial list. There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Nevertheless, there are some risks associated with snow sports that cannot be eliminated. You are ultimately responsible for your personal safety. Be aware of changing conditions; trail conditions vary constantly due to weather changes and

3 MOUNTAIN TOUR Where do you want to go?

From the Village to the Upper Mountains:

- From the top of the Village or Magic Lift, take **MIDWAY**.
- **Easiest Route** – **GARDEN PATH** to **MIDWAY**. Go left off of the Village lift, pass under the lift & follow **MIDWAY**.

From the Village to Morse Highlands:

- From **GARDEN PATH** at the top of the Village or Magic Lift, take **SAM'S RUN** to **DIXIE'S KNOLL**.

From the Upper Mountains to the Village:

- From the **Madonna base area**, take **MEADOWLARK**. Some flat spots, poling may be required.
- From **Madonna Mountain**, take **RUTHIE'S** to **MIDWAY**, then take a right onto **CURLEY'S CUTBACK** and follow **MEADOWLARK**. This route includes intermediate terrain and helps you avoid some flat spots, poling may be required.

Return to Parking Lot #1: From the top of the Sterling Lift, take **UPPER RUMRUNNER** to **BLACK SNAKE**. Then take the **PRACTICE SLOPE** stay to skiers' right, then cross over to skiers' left. **OR** take **UPPER RUMRUNNER** to **CROSSOVER** to **TREASURE RUN**. Then cross over the **PRACTICE SLOPE** stay to skiers' right, then cross over to skiers' left.

Shuttle Schedule

Between The Village Center & Parking Lot 1:
DAILY – Runs continually from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm

These markings are no guarantee of your safety and will not protect you from injury. It is not possible to mark all hazards. It is part of your responsibility to avoid all obstacles and hazards, including those that are marked. Failure to use good judgment, ski or snowboard responsibly, or follow the Responsibility Code will result in loss of skiing and snowboarding privileges without refund.

***Off Trail Policy**

Wooded areas between named trails and glades are not marked in any way, are not patrolled and have no skier/ snowboarder services. If you decide to ski or snowboard in wooded areas, within the ski area boundary, you are solely responsible for yourself. You should be an expert skier/ snowboarder and you should stay in groups of three or more.

Do not ski or snowboard on or across closed trails.

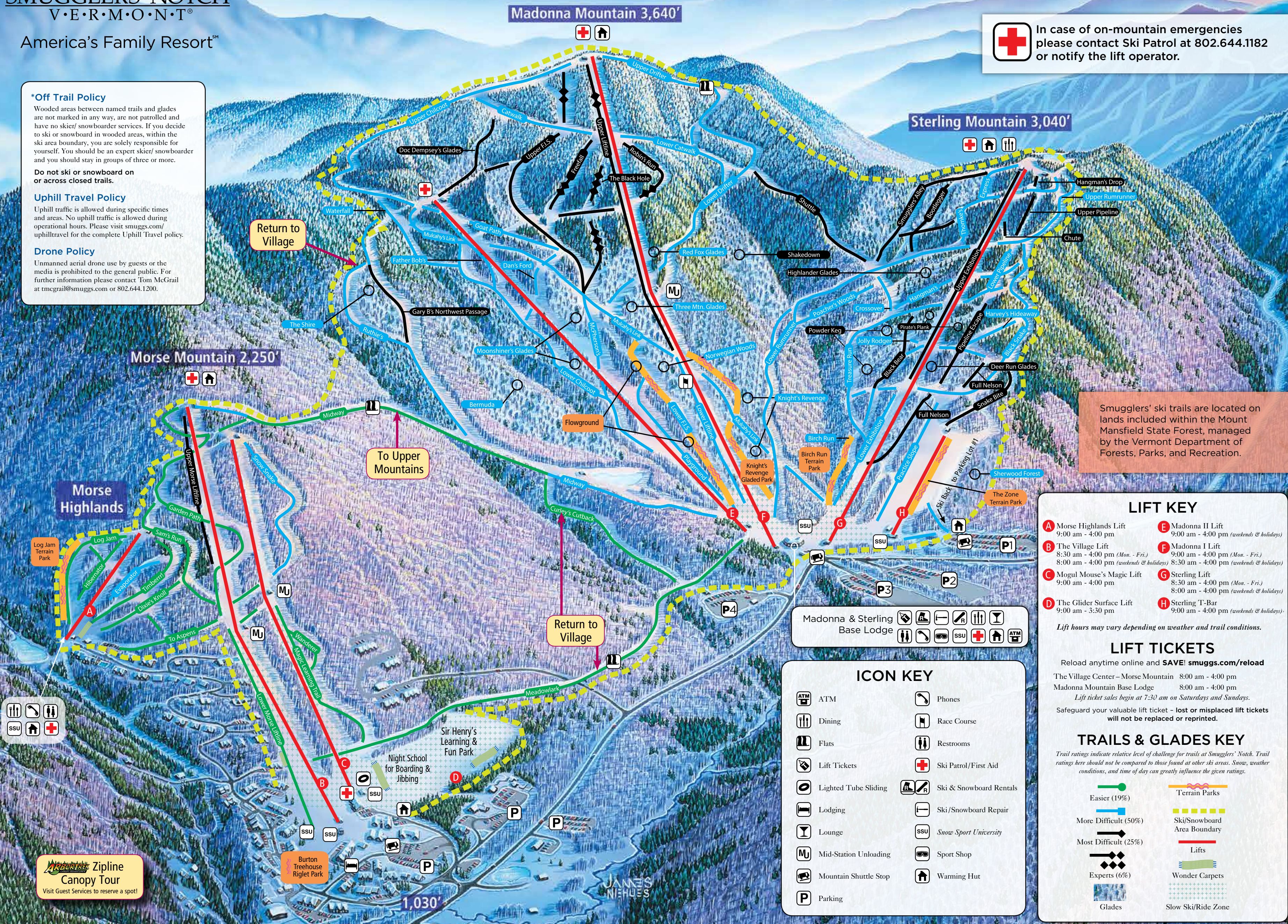
Uphill Travel Policy
