

79A.45.050: LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT

Any person who is involved in a skiing accident and who departs from the scene of the accident without leaving personal identification or otherwise clearly identifying himself or herself before notifying the proper authorities or obtaining assistance, knowing that any other person involved in the accident is in need of medical or other assistance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

79A.45.070: SKIING IN AN AREA OR TRAIL CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

Any person skiing outside the confines of trails open for skiing or runs open for skiing within the ski area boundary shall be responsible for any injuries or losses resulting from his or her action.
