ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

- 1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- 2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It's your responsibility to avoid them.
- 3. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4. Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- 5. If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
- 6. Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 7. Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
- 8. Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- 9. You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol and drugs.
- 10. You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.
