



Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in skiing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. - 1. Always ski in control, and be able to stop or avoid other skiers or objects.
- 2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is

- 4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- 6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails
- 7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to


