Non-compacted Zone

Ski on snow that hasn't been compacted (powder snow and bumps).

- * Snow-fall conditions may affect the size of the non-compacted zones. Snow may be compacted if there are large holiday crowds or the course condition appears to be dangerous.
- * Closed to beginners or skiers without proper equipment. * Zone will be limited to advanced skiers only in bad weather or if the course conditions are rough. * Ski with a partner(s).
