



Slide Mountain

Slide was the alternative site for the 1960 Winter Olympics. Beginners can choose from the 22 acre Bunny Bowl or the Little Red Chair Bowl, both served by chair lifts, or from 2 surface lifts near the Lodge. Intermediates and Experts look to the 9700 foot peak for exciting runs like Silver Dollar, Gold Run and Bonanza, served by two fast chair lifts, each a mile long.

Night skiing is the latest thing at Slide Mountain, with 1/2 mile of slope fully lighted. Buy a ticket at 1:00 p.m. and ski until 10:00 p.m. for just the normal day rate.

A complete system of snow making machines (the only high altitude snow making in the country) assures early opening on good cover. We constantly machine groom the bowls and trails to provide you with perfect skiing under any conditions.

The Ski School has something extra too. A television camera is set up for instant replay of your lessons... another modern way to learn along with the American and GLM techniques.

You'll like our food service and from "THE BAR" you can watch Carson City twinkle in the distance. The essentials, such as Nursery and Ski Shop are there to serve you too.

1. Little Red Chairlift. Beginners. Length: 790 feet. Vertical rise: 150 feet.

2. Poma Platter Pull. Beginners. Length: 1700 feet. Vertical rise: 270 feet.

3. Overland chair. Advanced, Intermediate and Beginners. Length: 4950 feet. Vertical rise: 1450 feet. Includes beginners unloading ramp... we call it Grand Central Station.

4. Pioneer Chair. Advanced and Intermediate. Length: 4850 feet. Vertical rise: 1450 feet.

(all new in 1973)

5. Pony lift (handle tow). Beginners. Length: 600 feet. Vertical rise: 100 feet.

6. Olympic Downhill. 2900 feet vertical.

△ Peak at 9700 feet. Chairlifts from each area converge at this point. Take advantage of the new combined lift ticket!

◇ Mt. Rose parking lot and lodge area.


7. Beginners Poma. Length: 1600 feet. Vertical rise: 250 feet.

8. Northwest Passage Double Chair. Advanced and Intermediate. Length: 4800 feet. Vertical rise: 1450 feet.

9. Ponderosa Double Chair. Beginners. Length: 3000 feet. Vertical rise: 360 feet.

10. Alphorn T-Bar. Intermediate. Length: 2200 feet. Vertical rise: 750 feet.


