## ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE

There are elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Regardless of how you decide to use the slopes, always show courtesy to others. Please adhere to the code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a safe outdoor experience.

- 1 Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people or objects.
- 2 People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It's your responsibility to avoid them.
- 3 Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4 Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
- 5 Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
- 6 Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
- 7 You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
- 8 If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to Ski Patrol.
- 9 Keep off closed trails and closed areas.
- 10 You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.

### Know the Code - Be Safety Conscious. It is Your Responsibility.

Know Your Boundaries - Silver Star Mountain Resort has no obligation to anyone going beyond ski area boundaries. Should persons choose to leave the ski area, they do so at their own risk and assume the burden of responsibility for their actions. Avalanche danger and other hazards exist. You are solely responsible for your safety, welfare, and costs of rescue.

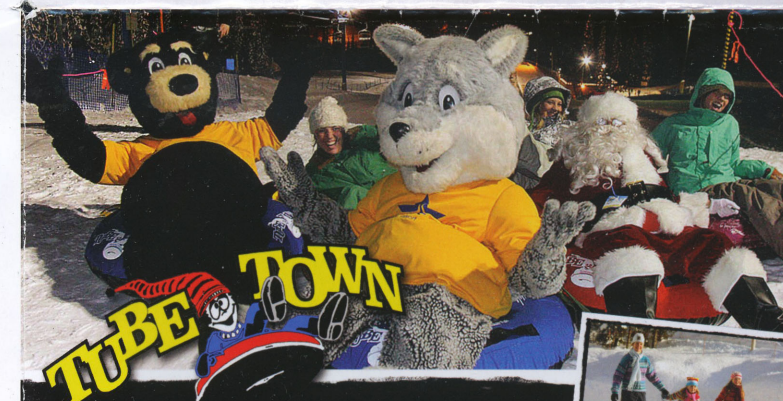

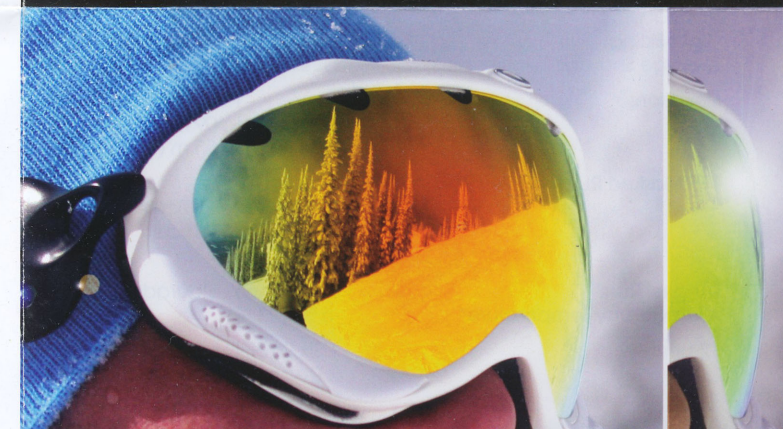
