THE AREA

Whitewater is located in the Selkirk Mountains of southeastern British Columbia, 19 km (12 miles) from the city of Nelson. It is easily accessible by bus or automobile with fine highways from the north, south, east and west. Daily flights by Pacific Western Airlines and Arrow Aviation to Castlegar, with connecting buslines, make the journey easier for the skier from distant points.

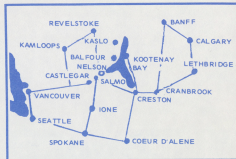
Vancouver is approximately 640 km (400 miles) to the west, Calgary 640 km (400 miles) east, Spokane 230 km (145 miles) south, and Revelstoke 250 km (155 miles) north.

From Nelson, access to Whitewater is by 9 km (6 miles) of main highway and 9 km (6 miles) of newly-constructed wide dual-lane road, maintained by the Department of Highways. The area provides parking space for up to 600 cars.

ALPINE DESIGN

Whitewater offers everything for the skier and the skiing family, including all levels of ability, from beginner to expert. An abundance of dry powder snow covers this beautiful basin and its large connecting bowls from November to May. Average snow depth is fifteen feet. The area is surrounded by the panorama of Mount Ymir which reaches an elevation of 2365 meters (7,885 feet). The splendor of Kootenay Glacier can be glimpsed from the area.

Both groomed runs and powder bowls are a dominant feature of the area. Trees have been kept in the alpine design as much as possible to provide gladed sheltered sloped throughout the spruce and balsam forest.



THE LODGE

Whitewater has a beautiful lodge on three levels. The lower two floors contain change area with lockers, full washroom facilities, a ski shop, repair service and rentals, the Whitewater Ski School, first aid and ski patrol headquarters, manager's office, and ticket sales office. The entire Whitewater staff is at your service.

The main floor with its open post and beam construction affords a panoramic view of Mount Ymir. Here both the skier and the non-skier can enjoy magnificent scenery and companionship. Full cafeteria services together with a club lounge and dance area complete the main floor interior. Surrounding the main floor is an eight-foot patio allowing enjoyment of warm sunny days and alpine setting.

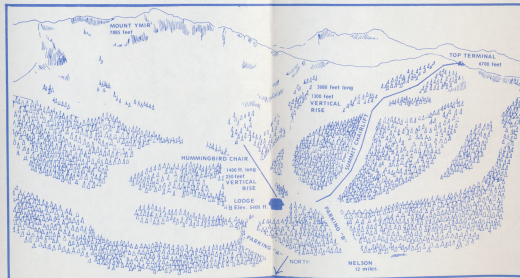
SKI SCHOOL

The Whitewater Ski School offers excellent instruction with your safety and fun being of prime importance. Both class and private lessons are available on a daily basis using the GLM method of instruction. School, college, and university classes are hosted. Equipment rentals are available at a moderate cost. Friendly instructors will gladly assist your needs.



ACCOMMODATIONS

Nelson provides approximately 400 units for the travelling skier. A range of types of accommodation and prices will appeal to every pocketbook. Generally however, the mid-price range for the weekend and 5-day packages will be found. Many of Nelson's lodgings are family owned and operated, guaranteeing personal, friendly surroundings. THE LIFTS

Whitewater is serviced by two chairlifts of high capacity and smooth, quiet electric operation.

The southern bowl area has a 942 meter (3,090 foot) lift with a vertical rise of 396 meters (1,300 feet). Three powder bowls, the Powder Keg, the Gold Pan, and the Glory Basin, are reached from the lift, called "Summit".

The 427 meter (1,400 foot) beginner's lift a unique advantage for the beginner, is called "Hummingbird", and rises only 76 meters (250 feet) vertically, taking the novice into a well groomed area of ideal snow conditions.

The lifts operate seven days a week with a capacity of 2,050 skier per hour, almost eliminating lift lineups.

APRES SKI

The short drive to the beautiful city of Nelson affords the skier with the best of both worlds. Nelson — the educational, governmental, and trading centre for the Kootenays, has developed a large tourist industry and is most anxious to serve the skier. Nelson has many good hotels, inns, motels, restaurants, nightclubs, cabarets, and recreational facilities for your apres ski enjoyment. Enjoy the mountain and the city on the same vacation.
