

...from the short barrier-free panorama trail from the Kreuzjoch mountain station to the new "StubaiBlick" observation deck! Our seats, designed by artists, invite you to take a break and relax. The impressive countryside and view along this trail give you strength and energy. The destination is the observation deck with breathtaking visibility – a place that touches all of your senses!

NEW: NATURE EDUCATION TRAIL (FINISHED FOR SUMMER 2009) ... let yourself be informed ...

Family-friendly hiking trail, suitable for baby carriages, with a slight incline, from the Kreuzjoch to the Schlicker Alm. Walking time: approx. 1 1/2 hrs.



ALPINE ADVENTURE DAYS FOR CHILDREN in conjunction with BIG Family Stubai (June 29 – Sept. 11, 2009) ... let yourself be fascinated...

... Every Monday – family hike – for children ages 5 and over: Parents can accompany their children on the hike or put them in the care of those in charge for FREE. Program: romping about on the adventure trail, forest and water games, action and fun, and much more.

... Every Thursday – climbing at the alpine adventure park – for children ages 10 and over: Under the supervision and guidance of a trained alpine guide you can cross canyons, rappel down a cliff and much more. (min. of 5 participants, registration required, EUR 15 per child) Meeting point for everyone: 10 am at the valley station or 10.15 am at the Kreuzjoch mountain station.

Return: Children ages 5 and over: 3.30 pm – Froneben middle station Children ages 10 and over: 4 pm – Schlick 2000 valley station



PANORAMASEE ... let yourself go ...

...surrounded by majestic mountains and green fir trees lies our PANO-RAMASEE in a beautiful setting with gentle banks for Kneipp therapy, lounging about and simply relaxing. This relaxation oasis in summer provides for snow-covered ski trails in winter.

ADVENTURE TRAIL ... let yourself be thrilled ...

...with game stations and barefoot paths right through the adventure trail (approx. 1 km) for big and small children. Consciously experiencing and being in touch with nature is the motto here. Children will have lots of fun in the crawling tunnel, on the rope slide and on the rope bridge at the giant playground near the Schlickeralm, etc. while adults can enjoy some Kneipp therapy in the fresh alpine water.



ALPINE FLORA EDUCATION TRAIL ... let yourself be enchanted...

...amidst the magnificently blooming flora which ranges from pioneer plants in stony cirques, colorful meadow flowers and alpine herbs to rare plants in the mountains. This extraordinarily fascinating journey of discovery starting from the Kreuzjoch mountain station lasts about 1 1 4 hours. From June 30 – Sept. 1, 2009 a free tour of the alpine flora education trail is offered every Tuesday. Meeting point at 9 am at the valley station. Use the trail at your own risk. Additional hiking tips can be found on page 15 and on the hiking maps available at our ticket windows.

ALPINE ADVENTURE PARK ... let yourself be challenged ... (see page 14/15 panorama map – Alpine Adventure Park 3 - 9)

...in the climbing garden with practice fixed vie ferrate, panorama via ferrata, rappelling cliff and rope slides from summit to summit. You need to have suitable equipment, a good head for heights and surefootedness. Children may not climb unsupervised. A mountain guide is on hand to assist novices. The rope slides may only be used with a mountain guide.



Panorama Restaurant Kreuzjoch – 2,136 m

Directly at the mountain station of the Kreuzjoch gondola, the restaurant can be easily reached in just 15 minutes. Enjoy the fascinating panoramic view and fine hospitality and relax on the lawn in a free lounge chair! Early morning get-together for drinks every Sunday complete with live music. Specialties: reasonably priced senior meals, daily homemade "Kaiserschmarren" (cut-up sugared

pancake with raisins), apple and curd strudel, extensive salad bar, mountain climber country platter. **Baked potatoes**, dumpling day on **Wednesdays**, giant Wiener Schnitzel day on **Saturday**. Sennjochhütte - 2,240 m

Alpengasthof Schlicker Alm - 1,645 m

Starkenburger Hütte – 2,229 m



The Stubai Card conveniently lets you enjoy the highlights and breathtaking alpine countryside. Discover sports, nature and culture in Stubaital for five days with the Stubai Card: down into and up the valley as well as uphill and downhill.

The Stubai Card includes the services listed below FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE CONSECUTIVE DAYS:

- FREE rides on buses of Innsbruck's transport system between Schönberg and Mutterberg (the ride to Innsbruck is to be paid for at the point of entry)
- FREE ride on the Stubaitalbahn Fulpmes Innsbruck Fulpmes
- FREE use of the indoor and outdoor pool in Fulpmes/Telfes
- FREE use of the indoor and outdoor pool in Neustift
- · FREE use of the pool in Mieders
- FREE use of the Stubaier Gletscherbahn, 1 uphill and downhill ride per day (except for ski passes)
- FREE use of the Serlesbahnen: 1 uphill and downhill ride per day (except for the summer toboggan run)
- FREE use of Schlick 2000 mountain cableway: 1 uphill and downhill ride per day

SALES LOCATIONS FOR THE STUBAI CARD

The Stubai Card is available from Serles Cableways in Mieders, the Schlick 2000 valley terminal in Fulpmes, the Elfer lifts and the Stubai Glacier valley terminal as well as the Stubai Tirol tourist offices in Fulpmes and Neustift.

USE OF THE STUBAL CARD

The 5-day period of validity of the Stubai Card begins at the time in which it is purchased. The Stubai Card is not transferrable. When purchased, the last day of validity and name of the owner are entered on the card. A picture ID of the card owner is to be shown in the event of a check. A Stubai Card will not be replaced if lost. Reimbursement for days that an individual service provider is closed cannot be granted.
