LIFT OPERATIONS

Lifts Open - 9:00 a.m.
 Lifts Close* - 4:00 p.m.

- All lifts and trails are open subject to weather and snow conditions.
- Lifts may open late on heavy snow mornings due to avalanche control.
- If unfamiliar with the lift loading process, please ask lift operator for instructions.
- *High Lift - 3:30 p.m.
- *North Face Lift - 3:00 p.m.
- *East River Lift - 3:30 p.m.

Lift Safety. Be advised that you cannot board a lift unless you have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to negotiate or to use such lift safely, or until you have asked for and received information sufficient to enable you to load, ride and unload the lift safely. You may not use a lift or any ski trail when under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

SMART STYLE

LOOK BEFORE YOU LEAP:
 SCOPE AROUND THE JUMPS FIRST, NOT OVER THEM. KNOW LANDINGS ARE CLEAR, AND CLEAR YOURSELF OUT OF THE LANDING AREA.

EASY STYLE IT:
 START SMALL AND WORK YOUR WAY UP. (INVERTED AERIALS NOT RECOMMENDED.)

RESPECT GETS RESPECT:
 FROM THE LIFTLINE THROUGH THE PARK.

SLEDS AND NON-DIRECTIONAL DEVICES PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON SKIING TERRAIN. SNOW MAINTENANCE VEHICLES OR SNOWMOBILES MAY BE ENCOUNTERED ON ANY TRAIL AT ANY TIME. KNOW THE CODE. IT'S YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.
