Please note that all trails within the Royal Gorge Track System are two way trails. While we welcome snowshoers, we request that you stay to the side of the trails and off the tracks and middle lanes; these areas are designed for track and skate skiers. Refer to the trail map or refer to current conditions for trails used exclusively for snowshoers. Please: no skiing on these trails.

TRAIL PASSES

BEFORE purchasing a trail pass and going skiing, please read the information on this map carefully and check weather and track conditions. All trails may not be open (especially during adverse conditions) and grooming quality can be affected by temperature, wind, rain and falling snow. Please read safety information

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS ON TRAIL PASSES.

TRACK SYSTEM

Entry is not permitted onto the track system before opening hours, or after 3:00 pm. Weather Reports and Track Conditions are available at Royal Gorge's Lodges and where trail passes are sold. Royal Gorge reserves the right to close trail systems due to adverse snow and weather conditions.

INTERSECTION NUMBERS

To help with orientation and map reading, numbers are printed at each intersection on the map. These numbers correspond with numbers posted on the trail signs located at each intersection in the track system.

A small portion, approximately 2%, of the Royal Gorge track system is on U.S. Forest Service Land of the Tahoe National Forest under a special use permit.
