**Olympic Trail**  
Max.30° | Av.21° | 650m

The course where the 1998 Nagano Winter Olympic Games were held. Challenge the hard course for advanced skiers!

**Panorama Out Trail**  
Max.21° | Av.10° | 2,500m

Northern Alps and Zenkoji Daira can be viewed at a glance. The exhilarating course which runs directly down into Shiga Kogen Prince Hotel South.

**Karamatsu Trail**  
Max.20° | Av.11° | 850m

Both the width and the angle of the slope are suitable for beginners and intermediate-level skiers. The best recommended course in Yakebitaiyama.

**Giant Slalom Trail**  
Max.25° | Av.11° | 2,400m

Fully enjoy the pleasure of running down the steep bank in the wonderful conifer forest.

**Shirakaba Trail**  
Max.23° | Av.12° | 1,100m

The course embraced by the white birch forest. Fully enjoy your romantic moments.

**East Trail**  
Max.21° | Av.11° | 1,100m

The well-maintained course of 600m length where poles are set. Night skiing may be enjoyed.
