- Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others. If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must remain at the scene and identify yourself to Ski Patrol
- Keep off closed trails and closed areas. 0
- You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired by alcohol or drugs. You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, 10
- ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant
